





THE FIVE-POINTED STAR


To make a five-pointed star with one stroke of the scissors or a single tear, take a square of paper about one-half larger than the size of star desired and fold it in half as shown by *A* in Fig. 73, the folded edge being at the bot-





tom. Now fold the right-hand end toward the center on a line running from the centre at the top to a point one-third of the distance from the right-hand corner at the top, as shown by the dotted line on *A*, which will give *B*. Then fold from right to left on the line shown in *B*, thus forming *C*. After that, fold the left-hand corner toward the right-hand corner, and the other folds and the result will be a five-pointed star. By cutting or tearing along the















































