Refreshable Braille Displays

Allow an Individual who is Blind to access all information on a computer or iPad via real-time refreshing Braille. Typically used in Conjunction with a screen reader such as JAWS or Voice Over.

- The iSense's unique light-sensitive film would consist of a grid of bubbles that reacts to varying levels of light, created by the iPad's screen. This would then create different patterns of small bumps, forming Braille characters on the film.



AAC Augmentative and Alternative Communication

Encompasses the communication methods used to supplement or replace speech or writing for those with impairments in the production or comprehension of spoken or written language. AAC is used by those with a wide range of speech and language impairments, including congenital impairments such as cerebral palsy, intellectual impairment and autism, and acquired conditions such as amyotrophic lateral sclerosis and Parkinson's disease. AAC can be a permanent addition to a person's communication or a temporary aid.
